PROGRAM INCOME

We do provide several programs that assist the pets in our community. Some of these programs we do charge a fee for, to establish accountability with the pet's owner.

The public can sign up for our Puppy Training Classes for a \$10 charge. The classes are held twice a month at All Paws Behavioral & Veterinary Clinic. The pet owner and their puppy get approximately 3 hours of professional training. We have an error in the income listed for the Puppy Classes, as there were approximately 100 participants in 2020, not 10, as shown below.

Our Spay & Neuter program is very popular. We only charge the pet owner \$20 for a voucher that they use at a participating veterinary clinic for a free spay or neuter surgery for their cat or dog. People line up sometimes hours in advance to ensure they get one of the limited number of vouchers (usually 65 vouchers), which are sold quarterly.

Puppy Training Classes

We renewed our contract with All Paws Behavioral & Veterinary Clinic this year. Dr. Mar Doering is an expert dog behavioralist, and we retain her services. She hosts puppy training classes at her clinic in Holts Summit twice a month for a limited number of puppies. The pet owner and their puppy get approximately 3 hours of professional training. She is also available for training of volunteers who handle animals, and animal shelter staff, although we did not conduct this training this year. This fee is for hours of her services, not an annual fee.

Salvation Army Food Pantry

In partnership with the Heart of Missouri Humane Society, we purchase 60 bags of dog and cat food each month for the Salvation Army Food Pantry, to be distributed to individuals in need of assistance. Helping people who are down on their luck with pet food keeps beloved pets in homes. Due to the Salvation Army's COVID-19 restrictions they did not distribute as much pet food as usual, and we only restocked their food supply 9 months this year.

Animal Shelter Assistance

We purchase cardboard cat carriers and require that every cat adopted from the JCAS leave in a carrier, if they do not bring their own. We cause this Lois's Law, after a kitten who was lost after leaping from her new family's arms in the parking lot.

We also purchase cat scratching discs for the cat kennels. This is an enrichment item for the cats and reduces their stress during their stay.

We purchase an annual subscription of Kind News magazine, which we have available in the JCAS lobby for children visitors to take home with them. A we also purchase an annual subscription of Animal Sheltering magazine for the staff at JCAS.

We did purchase 20 animal themed Christmas stockings from a People Helping Paws fundraiser that were given to adopters at the JCAS as an adoption promotion in the month of December.

We purchased 3 universal microchip scanners for each of the animal control trucks, so that the officers can scan pets in the field versus driving them to the shelter, getting them home faster.

We donated 17 cases of canned cat food to the Central Mo Humane Society in Columbia to assist them with a cat hoarding case that they were overwhelmed with.

We did pay to have the exterior windows at the JCAS cleaned in June.

Animal Shelter Improvements

The JCAS needed to replace the plastic cat kennels in the vet room and intake areas. The plastic kennels were harboring bacteria and mold. We voted to fund replacing half of these kennels in 2020 with stainless steel kennels. The new kennels include portals that allow cats multiple rooms, so they can have more room, lessening their stress, especially for litters.

We purchased bench seating for the JCAS lobby and cat room. It can be disinfected, whereas the previous upholstered chairs could not be.

We purchased a 55" Samsung TV and mini computer for the JCAS lobby. The shelter manager uses this to display adoption photos, pet tips, and event promotions.

We added a music speaker to the new acquaintance room, and purchased some décor items for this room. We converted a storage room to an acquaintance room in 2019.

We purchased and hung 20 canvas photos of previous JCAS tenants. These beautiful photos are a welcome addition to the lobby, acquaintance room, cat room, and small furry room.

We continue to maintain the landscaping at JCAS. We purchase plants, mulch, soil, and perform the labor associated with this. We also added a few potted plants to the lobby and entrance.

Wild Thing - Feral Feline Fix

In partnership with the Heart of MO Humane Society we funded Trap Neuter Return (TNR), spay/neuter surgeries and rabies vaccinations for feral and community cats. The volunteers that make up Wild Things were able to have 689 un-owned cats altered and vaccinated, then returned to field. This greatly reduces the number of stray kittens and unadoptable cats from entering the animal shelter. The Baker Family Charitable Trust did earmark a \$5,000 donation for this program, and additional memorial donations were received. The Wild Thing volunteers also assisted the JCAS with a nuisance cat complaint on Michigan Street.


